Elementary:

Kinder Connect and First Grade Fundamentals Entering Kindergarten & 1st Grade	Students will be engaged with meaningful literacy experiences through daily read aloud and shared readings. Students will gain important prereading /writing concepts such as print awareness, phonological awareness, letter/sound knowledge, oral language, vocabulary, comprehension and writing fluency.
Summer Scholars Entering 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade	Targeting literacy and math intervention for students with identified needs in those areas. Students will be engaged in comprehensive and meaningful instruction using evidence-based practices.
Stem/Literacy Learning Camp <i>Entering 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Grade</i>	Students will engage with high-interest science-based texts to develop vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension strategies. Students will engage in science and engineering activities and investigations.

Middle School:

Math Mindset Summer Camp Entering 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade	A program designed for students who think math is not their strength. It is a researched based program that is designed to build the student's confidence in their math abilities and remain persistent even when the work is difficult.
Middle School Readers & Writers Entering 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade	This is a work-shop based camp that focuses on daily opportunities to read, write, and discuss ideas with their peers.

ECSE Summer Program Current ECSE Students	Focus on improving school readiness, such as pre-literacy, pre-math, and emergent motor skills, as well as addressing communication skills. Instructional programming will align with student IEPs. Related Speech and Social Work services, will also be afforded based on IEP programming.
Elementary CI Program Entering K-5th Grade with IEP	Focus on academic growth, socio-emotional learning, adaptive life skills, and functional independence. Instructional services will align with student IEPs.
Middle School CI Program Entering 6-8th Grade with IEP	Focus on academic growth, socio-emotional learning, adaptive life skills, and functional independence. Instructional services will align with student IEPs.
K-3rd Grade Resource Room K-3rd Graders with IEP/RR	Instructional programming will align with student IEPs.
4th & 5th Grade Resource Room <i>4th & 5th Graders with IEP/RR</i>	Instructional programming will align with student IEPs.
6th-8th Grade Resource Room 6th-8th Graders with IEP/RR	Instructional programming will align with student IEPs.
