2025-2026 Scholarship Application

Deadline: March 6, 2026 in the Athletic Office to the Attention of Mr. Spezia

The purpose of this scholarship is to reward student athletes for their participation and accomplishments in athletics, academic performance, leadership and service within the community. Six scholarships will be awarded to athletes from the Senior class (provided six or more candidates qualify) (Boosters Board reserves the right to give more than six). In order to be eligible to receive the Anchor Bay Athletic Booster Club Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

1. Athlete must have earned a varsity letter at Anchor Bay in at least one sport.
2. Submitted applications must include the signature of a Coach.
3. Athlete must be accepted to a College, University, or Technical School.
4. Athlete must have a cumulative GPA no lower than 2.5.
5. Application must be legible. Athlete must complete and sign application and submit (physically or electronically) to Mr. Spezia on by the **deadline of March 6, 2026. Late applications will not be accepted.**
6. Parents/Guardians must be in good standing with the booster club - ie., dues paid and meet the criteria of being an active member:
 - a. The member has obtained the age of 21 years old.
 - b. The member obtains active status by any of the following:
 - i. Attends three (3) monthly meetings over the last twelve (12) month period;
 - ii. Works as a volunteer for an Anchor Bay All Sports Boosters activity.
 - iii. Works as club officer or committee chairperson.
7. If any scholarship recipient has not requested their funds by 12/31/26, the scholarship award shall pass to the next runner-up.
