What is Dual Enrollment?



- Dual enrollment allows high school students to take college courses while still in high school.
- Students can earn both high school and college credit at the same time.
- Dual enrollment courses can be taught by high school, college, or adjunct faculty.
- They can be taken on campus or online.

What are the advantages?

- Exposure to college level classes
- Adding classes and rigor to the transcript
- Course available beyond those offered at Anchor Bay High School
- Earn college credit for free – up to 10 college courses





What are the disadvantages?

- Effect on college GPA
- Effect on high school GPA
- Most Ivy League schools **do not** accept dual enrollment transfer credits (UofM)
- Loss of Dual Enrollment privileges –
 - If a student fails a course, they will no longer be able to do dual enrollment
 - Student will be responsible for course payment



Course Limits

- Up to 10 courses overall can be covered under the Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act. For a student that first dual enrolls in:
 - 9th grade – not more than two courses per year in 9th, 10th, and 11th grade, and not more than four courses in grade 12.
 - 10th grade – not more than two courses in 10th grade, and not more than four courses in 11th and 12th grade.
 - 11th or 12th grade – not more than four courses in 11th grade, and not more than six courses in 12th grade.

How Does this work?

- You'll drop one or more ABHS classes depending on how many college classes you take.
- Anchor Bay Schools will only pay for 10 DE courses.
- You can take classes in person or online
- Typical schedule if you start DE your 11th grade year

Important Reminders

- Students **MUST** have a qualifying test score on the PSAT/SAT:
 - **Reading – PSAT: 460 / SAT: 480**
 - **Math – 510**

- Take courses that ABHS *does not* offer
 - If ABHS offers that course as an AP option, you cannot take it through DE

STEP 2



- Go to:
www.macomb.edu/start
- Create an admission account
- Start and submit an application
- Watch your email for your ID number and next steps

STEP 3

- Once you receive your student ID number, complete the MCC admission steps:

- Watch for link in your email to log into your Macomb Admission Account
 1. New Student Orientation
 2. Self-placement in Math and English
 3. Starting at Macomb (SAM) Call 586-445-7999, option 2. Mention that you are a Dual Enrollment student.
 4. Watch your email for directions and temporary password to activate your My Macomb Account.



STEP 4

- Register as soon as you can once registration opens.
- Please do not sign up for extra classes.
- If you were approved for 2 classes, sign up for ONLY 2 classes.
- Students who register for extra courses may have to self-pay for them.
- **Students who change their registered courses without consulting their high school counselor will be responsible for the bill.**

Dual Enrollment Eligibility

Students must demonstrate college readiness by achieving qualifying scores on a prescribed standardized test. Students who do not meet test score requirements will be considered on a case-by-case basis based on their GPA, behavior, and attendance.

- PSAT/SAT: Reading and Writing Score _____ > 460
- PSAT/SAT: Math Score _____ ≥ 510

Rules and Eligibility: Parents, please initial each line to show understanding and acceptance of rules and eligibility

- _____ Classes taken at the college cannot conflict time-wise with classes at the high school. Students will be required to drop their college class if there is a conflict with their high school classes.
- _____ Students may not enroll in classes offered by the district unless it is determined by the district that a scheduling conflict exists with the high school course.
- _____ Each dual enrollment class will replace one (1) hour of class time at ABHS.
- _____ The student may not take more than 10 college courses while enrolled at Anchor Bay.
- _____ If the course fulfills an MMC credit toward graduation, the grade will be included on the student's transcript and counted toward the GPA. If a class does not fulfill a graduation requirement, it will be reflected on the transcript as CREDIT/ NO CREDIT and will not be counted toward the GPA.
- _____ The student must be enrolled in both the school district **AND** the postsecondary institution during the academic trimester.
- _____ The student must maintain regular attendance in all classes (high school and college).
- _____ The student must provide verification of college enrollment as requested by the school counselor.
- _____ The student must leave the Anchor Bay High School campus once the student has completed all high school classes for the day. In other words, students can only be in the high school when they have registered high school classes.
- _____ If a student drops, is dropped from a course, or fails to receive college credit for a course, they will be responsible for reimbursement to the district for the class.
- _____ For 2025-2026, students are allotted \$725.00 for tuition, fees, and books per class. Any amount above this is the student's responsibility.
- _____ If a student fails a dual enrollment course, they will not be permitted to register for future dual enrollment classes.
- _____ Anchor Bay School District is billed directly by the college. There is no reimbursement process for the student.

To the parents/guardians of Dual Enrolled students:

"A student that does not receive college credit for a course under the Dual Enrollment legislation is required to repay the school district (or the Department of Treasury in the case of a nonpublic school) any funds that were expended for the course that were not already refunded by the eligible postsecondary institution. If the student does not repay the funds as described in [MCL 388.514], the district may impose sanctions as determined by school policy. A student may take dual enrolled courses (including ones that were previously taken unsuccessfully) if the funds are repaid and if they still meet all other eligibility requirements."
