





It's the only way to be included on the Senior Composite




# Senior Portraits--Prestige

The last date to be photographed at Prestige and appear in the yearbook is November 14, 2025




# Senior Portraits— Non-Prestige

You are responsible for delivering your Senior Portrait to Ms. Smilnak by December 12, 2025.







My plans after high school are to attend and play softball at the University of Detroit Mercy and receive an education to become a Physical Therapist.




