



Information Regarding Spring Testing for 9th Grade Families

In April, we will be administering **mandatory** state testing which will impact our normal school schedule on April 9 & 10. Please refer to the information below to understand our upcoming testing and school times.

Monday, April 7: Normal School Day

Students will attend classes according to their normal daily schedule.

Tuesday, April 8: Normal School Day

Students will attend classes according to their normal daily schedule.

Wednesday, April 9: No School – Only 10th & 11th grade students present for state testing.

Thursday, April 10: Mandatory In-Person PSAT 8/9 Testing for ALL Freshmen

- **Students report at regular start time; busing will be provided.**
- Breakfast will be available before testing, if interested.
- **Post-testing dismissal will be at approximately 11:15 am. Bussing will be provided.**
- Students are encouraged to bring their own calculators.
- Testing will occur in small groups with a minimum of three-foot distancing.
- All testers must test in-person @ ABHS.

Friday, April 11: Normal School Day

Students will attend classes according to their normal daily schedule.

IMPORTANT: Cell phones & smart watches are NOT permitted during testing. Students should leave these devices at home, if at all possible. If devices are brought into the testing room, they must power off these devices, and student will not have access to them for the duration of the testing time. Any disturbance caused by prohibited devices will negatively impact all testers and could cause answer documents to become invalid.

Any food/drink brought on the day of testing will remain in the hallway for access during one of the break times.

No hats or hoods are allowed to be worn during testing.
