## Senior Year - Class of 2026 - Checklist

Every high school senior should begin thinking about what they are going to do after graduation. These plans could include attending college, joining the military, entering the work force or becoming certified in a skilled trade. On that note, the high school guidance counseling staff is here to help. Over the next several months, seniors will meet with their counselors in person to discuss plans. Below is a list of things all seniors should keep in mind:

- Graduation requirements 24.5 credits are required to graduate
- <u>Transcripts</u> All transcripts are sent electronically via Parchment. Follow the link below with directions on how to create a Parchment account at <a href="https://youtu.be/w8RhTWXWxa4">https://youtu.be/w8RhTWXWxa4</a>. Visit <a href="https://www.parchment.com/u/registration/13746/account">https://www.parchment.com/u/registration/13746/account</a> to create an account and request your transcript.
- College Applications/Tours/Visits Now is the time for seniors to apply to colleges if they have not already done so. Please make sure to pay attention to each colleges' specific deadlines. Consider using Commonapp.org. Use the College Visits tab to find information on setting up college visits as well as dates for virtual informational meetings for Michigan colleges.
- o FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid: (go to www.studentaid.gov to apply)
  - The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) SHOULD be available beginning October 1<sup>st</sup> 2025. If not, please continue checking FAFSA to complete the form.
  - Many colleges/universities require for you to complete FAFSA.
  - If you plan on borrowing money for college from the federal government, the FAFSA must be filled out.
  - Financial Aid /FAFSA Virtually Workshop Night:
    - o Will be done virtually on September 24, 2025 @ 8pm-9pm.
    - This provides FAFSA step-by-step instructions.
    - o This is <u>not</u> a general information night.
    - Both student and parent/guardian MUST attend.
