Welcome Back! We are looking forward to a great start to the school year!
Please see the information below regarding student arrival and dismissal procedures.

ARRIVAL:

School starts at 9:00 AM, the building doors will be opened at 8:50 AM.

- Bus Riders in Grades Y5, K and 1st: Students enter using Door #3
- Bus Riders in Grades 2nd – 5th: Students enter using Door #2
- Car Riders in Grades Y5, K: Students enter using Door #3
- Car Riders in Grade 1st: Students enter in Door #3 **OR** Door #10 (depending on siblings)
- Car Riders in Grades 2nd – 5th: Students enter using Door #10

Students are asked to go directly to their classrooms every morning; staff will be available to assist new or younger students. Breakfast will be available starting on the first full day of school.

Breakfast will be available in the classroom for grades Y5, K and 1st.

Students in grades 2nd – 5th can go through the cafeteria line for breakfast every morning starting at 8:50 AM.

Breakfast is free for all students.

DISMISSAL:

Dismissal is officially 3:51 PM. Y5 and Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 3:45 PM.

- Bus Riders in Grades Y5, K and 1st: Students exit using Door #3
- Bus Riders in Grades 2nd – 5th: Students exit using Door #2

- Car Riders in Grades Y5, K: Students exit using Door #3
 - Parent Pick-Up- across from the playground/in front of blue fence
 - Teachers must see parents before releasing them
- Car Riders in Grades 1st – 5th: Students exit using Door #10

For parent pick up and drop off, we ask that parents remain in cars and follow the “loop” to drop students off or pick them up directly in front of Door #10. This will help us make sure that all students are safe, and the traffic flow can be managed. As an alternative, parents can park in a designated parking spot and walk their child up to the door or pick them up from Door #10.

Visitors: We are not allowing parents to walk through the building. If you have supplies or items to drop off, please label them clearly with your child’s name and teacher name and put them on the table in the vestibule inside Door #1. Then, ring the doorbell to let the office staff know you have dropped something off.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to get students in and out of the building safely.
