LIGHTHOUSE PLAYGROUND EXPECTATIONS

Rev. October 1, 2020

PLAYGROUND EXPECTATIONS

Students need time to get outside, socialize and exercise. We expect children to participate in outdoor lunch recess. Therefore, students should dress appropriately for the weather conditions. Please review the following recess and playground expectations with your child.

Student Expectations:

- 1. Students must use hand sanitizer before and after recess time.
- 2. Students will wear proper shoes for recess and outdoor play.
- 3. Students will walk quietly out of the building.
- 4. Students will not play rough on the playground.
- 5. Students will stay away from puddles, wet areas and mud.
- 6. Students are to stop what they are doing when recess ends (whistle will be blown) and should line up quickly.
- 7. Students will leave rocks, bark, sticks, and other dangerous objects alone.
- 8. Students will show pride in their school by keeping the building and grounds free of litter.
- 9. Students will take turns on equipment.
- 10. Students must return all balls, jump ropes, chalk, etc. to the proper place.- if we can use equipment
- 11. Students will stay in the designated playground area (away from classroom windows) and must ask permission to use restrooms during recess.
- 12. Students will play safely, NO TAG or chasing games!

General school rules and consequences do apply to recess behavior. The following disciplinary steps will be taken if necessary:

- Verbal Warning
- Time Out- "on the wall" 5 minutes or less
- Communication with the Principal
- Behavior Referral (Conference with principal, possible Lunch Detention if behavior continues, etc)
- Sent Directly to the Office for severe behaviors (Detention, Suspension, etc)

Playground equipment is for everyone! Be sure to be polite to others waiting a turn.

Equipment Guidelines:

Infinity Loop

• Students must play safely on this equipment by going in a clock-wise direction. (Not appropriate for Kindergarten students)

Spinner

- Line up on sidewalk area near the spinner, riders must take turns. After your turn is over get off and let the next person in line have a turn
- Anyone not riding must stay away from spinner
- One-two students at a time on spinner
- No kneeling stand appropriately

Swings

- One person per swing- sit on your bottom, do not jump off
- No standing on swings or twisting swings around
- If you are pushing someone, push properly and be sure stay out of the way of other swings
- Students should stay clear of the swing area if not swinging or pushing

Playscape/Slide

Slide down feet first, on your bottom, single person only. No running, pushing or shoving.

Only **one** person may climb the ladders up to the clubhouse area at a time. One person down twisty pole and slides at a time. Do not climb up the slides. Slide down, face forward-<u>feet first, on your bottom, single person only</u>. Be careful, do not stand at the bottom of slide. There is no climbing, hanging or jumping from the tops or rails of any play areas at any time.

Monkey Bars

Use hands only, other students stand clear

If you cannot reach without help you cannot go on the monkey bars or the turning wheel. (When students help others someone often gets hurt.) Only one person may cross at a time. Others should wait their turn keeping the beginning and ending areas clear. Enter from the <u>end</u> of the playscape going one way only. **No flipping off of the equipment or climbing** on sides or top of these areas.

Turning Wheel

Use hands only, other students stand clear

If you cannot reach without help you cannot go on the turning wheel. (When students help others someone often gets hurt.) Four students may be on the wheel at a time. Others should wait their turn in a LINE, keeping a 4 foot distance from the wheel. **No climbing** on top of this areas.

Rock Climbers—large and mini climbers

If you wish to go on the rock climber, you must have appropriate footwear. Make sure that the equipment is dry, to avoid slipping. Do not touch others who are climbing on the wall. Do not sit on top of the large wall. Once you have reached the top go back down. If someone is in front of you, wait your turn.

Balance Beam

If you wish to go on the balance beam, you must have appropriate footwear. Make sure that the equipment is dry, to avoid slipping. If someone is in front of you, wait your turn.

Basketball, Four Square and Catching Games- pending approval to use balls and equipment

- All balls must be used on the blacktop or grassy areas and away from the swings and playscape (except for ball tube by Big Stone School fence)
- Basketball games are to be played with teams of <u>four-five</u> students only
- Basketball and Four Square are to be played on the blacktop or cemented areas
- · Catching games should be played on the grassy area

STANDARD DO'S AND DON'TS ON THE PLAYGROUND

Sanitize your hands before and after recess. Do get permission before going inside the school for anything. (Office, bathroom, locker, etc.) Do let one of the playground adults know if there are any problems or if someone is bothering you or a friend. Do let one of the playground adults know if you are hurt or if you see someone hurt. Do line up as soon as the whistle blows. Keep your hands to your side and face forward once you are in line. Do help out a fellow student in need.	Do not go out of the fenced area or designated play areas or anywhere that you cannot be seen. Do not play in the area near the school windows. Do not pick up wood chips or throw them. No pushing, pulling, tackling or kicking. Hands off others at all times. No food or drinks are allowed on the playground. No personal balls are to be brought out to recess- without permission. Do not go on the snowy areas without proper snow gear- boots, gloves/mittens and snow pants.
Always be respectful, polite, take turns and play fair.	Do NOT throw ice or snow!
	Do not slide on icy areas.
