- Spirit Wear/Gym Day/Restaurant Nights (Beverly)
 - Tomorrow 11/12 is the first restaurant night Texas Roadhouse. We are doing our first ever bake sale there also.
 - Gym Jam is Saturday Dec 7th. If we get 75 kids to attend, we get \$1000!
 - Put in a request for a restaurant night at Knapps City Garage.
 - Order for class shirts is in, Beverly is going to pick them up tomorrow evening.
 - Spirit wear order is placed.
- Popcorn Days (Emily)
 - Next popcorn day is Friday 11/15. Mrs Walquist donated 2 boxes of bags. Popcorn days are going well!
- Santa Shop (Emily)
 - Getting ready to get classes signed up. Going through a company this year. Volunteers still needed, sign up sheets at meetings, or contact Emily. Items are going to be a variety of prices. We will still have \$1-\$2 items, but for kids who bring more \$, there will be more expensive items, so they don't have to buy a bunch of small things. The company provides all the signage, wrapping tools and shopping items. We pay the company at the end of the santa shop with what we made. We chose 10% price markup which is the lowest amount. If we run out of an item, they will ship it overnight to us so we can set it out the next day for the next group. We are also able to sell our excess inventory that we have from shops in the past.
 - Last year we budgeted for \$4000. We won't be spending that much. We anticipated for nothing coming in, but will hopefully be making a profit.
- Cookies with Santa (Patty)
 - Coming up on Thurs Dec 19th (6-8pm). Cookies will likely come from BJs. Gluten free and Sugar free options. Frosting and sprinkles for cookies. Napkins, plates, cups, looking to get donations from Amazon Wish List. Candy Canes, looking for donations to be dropped off (similar to the halloween candy for trunk or treat).
