Volunteers: Holidays are coming up! Please remember that all school visitors must have an Anchor Bay Volunteer Form completed in advance. Forms must be filled out annually two weeks prior to the event. Forms are available online or in the office.

Dismissal Changes: Please contact the office **prior to 2:30 pm** to accommodate any changes to how your child gets home. We cannot make any guarantees after this time.

Tardy: If you bring your child in late, you do not need to sign them in on the blue sheet in the

vestibule. The office will take care of it. If the child was at a Doctor's appointment, please bring a Doctor's note in.

Dressing for school and outdoor activities:

Make sure your child dresses appropriately for the weather. We go outside **every day** for recess unless it is raining, the wind-chill is below 16°, or the wind speed is above 26 mph.



Picking up Early: If you are picking your child up early from school, please wait in the vestibule after speaking with office staff. Please do not go outside to your car to wait for them. We cannot have a child leave without a parent present.

Absences: If your student is sick, or has a fever, call our sick call line at (586) 725-0284 ext. 1401. Any unreported absences to the office will be recorded as unexcused. **Children need to be fever free and not vomiting for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.**

Extra Clothes: Please send an extra pair of clothes for your child to keep in their locker. The office is running **very** low on clothing, especially for girls. If you have clothing from the school at home, please return it for other children to use.

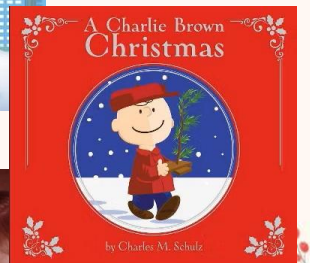
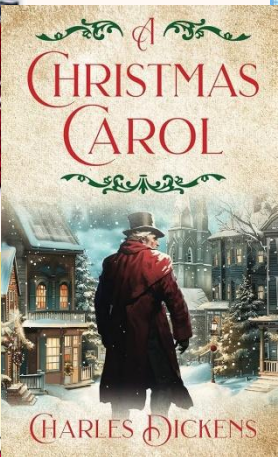
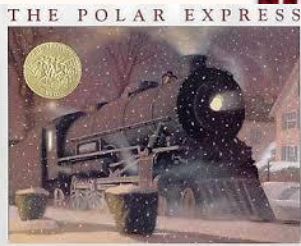
