The Giving Tree Committee, Officers of the New Baltimore and Chesterfield Police Departments and the Girl Scouts, engaged local schools, fire departments and churches to locate eligible families and identify needs. With enthusiastic support from local residents and businesses, this program grew rapidly to serve an increasing number of families and communities throughout Macomb and St Clair County and became its own 501(c)3 non-profit community organization ran by a local group of volunteers. Communities we serve range from Chesterfield, Ira Twp, New Haven, Fair Haven, New Baltimore, and Lenox Twp just to name a few.

In our 26th years of the program, our Community Giving Tree has supported approximately 3,300 local families and well over 7,000 children, making sure no child went without warm clothing, school supplies, food and a Christmas celebration.
