Feed the Bay Backpack Program

Purpose: Each school year, approximately 1 in 4 students in the Anchor Bay School District qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. To qualify for this program, students must be considered “at risk for food insecurity” and these students are provided with a nutritious hot lunch Monday through Friday, but not the weekends. The goal of the **Feed the Bay Backpack Program** is to ensure that every at-risk student in the Anchor Bay School District has access to food over the weekend, so that they show up at school on Monday, well-nourished and ready to learn. Every Friday, a bag of non-perishable foods will be placed in the student’s locker.
